

What the game lacks in control and execution, it more than makes for in the dark and scary atmosphere, the terrifying and entrancing sual design and the surrealistic levels. Sound design for the game is so amazing; the music adds intensity and fright to the game in just e right places. Odd sounds floating around everywhere — like the ound of a crying child echoing through the hallways, far off sounds of achinery and ghosts and the howling of the cold wind — heighten nsion and add to the effect of the horror in the game.

"Silent Hill" is definitely a game to check out and is fun to play in a ark room in the early hours of the morning. It is definitely one of the best horror games to be released and should set new standards for upoming horror and psychological thriller games. (Grade: A-)
