Battle of the Brazos

Aggies travel to Baylor Friday, host Bears Saturday, Su

The Texas A&M Baseball Team might not be humming the Barenaked Ladies' "It's All Been Done Before" as they head into their annual conference series against the Baylor University Bears, but it certainly is fitting.

Last year, the teams met with the Big 12 regular-season title on the line in the last weekend of the series, and this year, even though the series has been moved up on the calendar, the stakes remain high.

A&M comes in ranked fifth nationally by Baseball America. The Bears stand at seventh but hold a half-game lead over the Aggies for the top spot in the Big 12 conference and face an easier schedule down the home stretch.

The Aggies close the season with a home series against the University of Kansas and a home game against archrival University of Texas before playing two games in Austin and a road series against the University of Oklahoma.

The conference title will again be decided on winning percentage because of weather cancellations which have affected both team. A&M lost a game to snow against Texas Tech University, and the Bears lost their entire series to the University of Nebraska because of a blizzard.

The Aggies will try to get ahead early in the series by throwing staff ace and Waco native Casey Fossum at the Bears in the first game of the series Friday night.

Fossum will return to the mound at Baylor's Ferrell Field hoping to duplicate his performance of last year, when he struck out 15 in an 8-4 complete game win over Baylor's Jason Jennings, who also went the dis-

tance and struck out 14 Aggie batters.

Jennings will again oppose Fossum on Friday night after establishing himself as a leading contender for Pitcher of the Year this season. Jennings has put up an 8-0 record with a 2.34 ERA this year, compared to Fossum's 7-3 mark and 2.51 ERA.

The Saturday and Sunday games will be played at Olsen

Field, which hosted an all-time record crowd of 9,151 when the Bears came to town last season.

Junior Chance Caple will take the hill for the Aggies in the Saturday game against Bears' pitcher Chad Hawkins, and either sophomore Chris Russ or senior Matt Ward, who pitched the Sunday game against the Bears last season, will get the start for Sunday's game against lefthander


