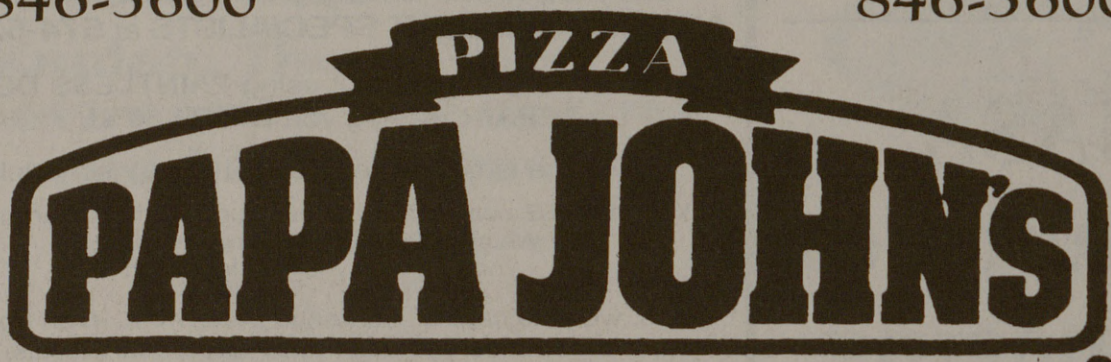

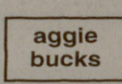

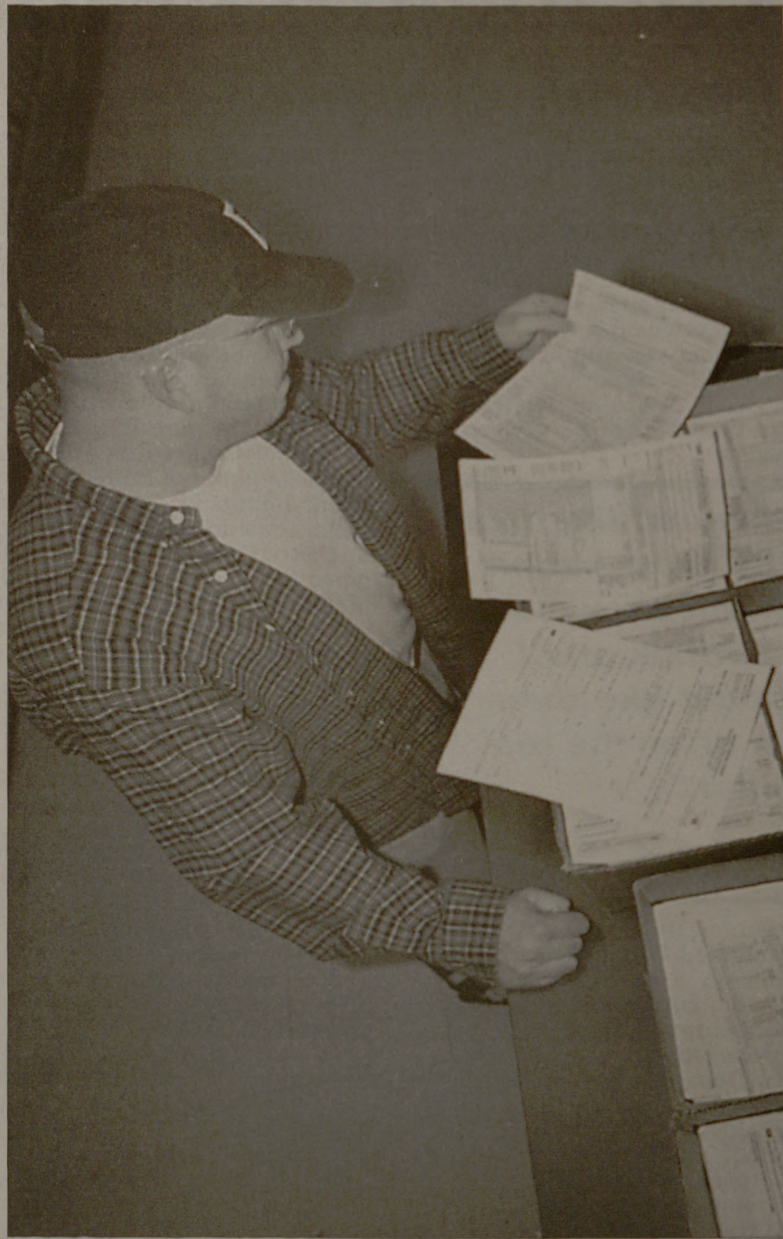

### Authors give read at Literacy Festival

A children's literacy festival will attract children's book authors and literacy organizations to downtown Bryan on Saturday, April 17, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday. Project Bookmarks, students of the George Washington University and the University of Texas at Austin, will be at 26th and 27th streets. Authors will read to children, performers will entertain, and organizations will host the festival. Brian Walker, a student at the Bush School, will be giving a book to a child attending the festival. Parking will be free, and refreshments will be offered. Walker said the festival is designed for children ages 5 to 12 years old, but children of all ages are welcome. Jacque's Toys and Books will offer 15 activities centered around popular children's books. Linda Burney, executive director of the Texas Literacy Council, said the festival is a great way to promote literacy efforts to children, and their success in the future. "Developing positive attitudes and feelings about books and reading now, is the way to ensure literacy," she said. According to the National Institute for Literacy, more than 50 percent of adults read at a fifth-grade level. Other organizations participating in the festival include the Public Library and the Museum of the Brazos.
