District appeals school prayer to Supreme Court

• 5th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals denies Santa Fe Independent School District right for prayer at football games.

GALVESTON, Texas (AP) — A Galveston County school board has voted 5-0 to take its fight for prayer at football games to the U.S. Supreme Court.

"I feel real good (that) we're going to appeal this," John Couch, president of the Santa Fe Independent School District board, said after Wednesday night's meeting.

"I think we're doing the right thing. How can you tell 17- and 18-year-old students that they can't stand up and give a message as they see fit? It's an outrage."

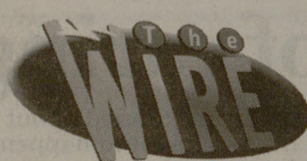
