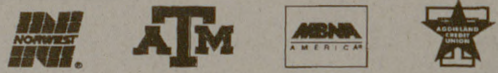

Slamfest '99

25 teams participate in basketball tournament

Richard Jackson and his teammates dominated the court Saturday at the MSC Hospitality Slamfest '99 3-on-3 basketball tournament.

Twenty-four male teams and one female team participated in the double-elimination tournament.

Teams were composed of Texas A&M students and non-students who entered advanced and beginner brackets.

Jackson, a senior agricultural economics major, said the outcome of the advanced bracket championship game was difficult to determine until nearly the end.

"Then we started making our shots, and they missed, so we pulled ahead," he said.

There are 10 members on Jackson's team who participate in four tournaments per semester.

The members take turns participating in the various tournaments. Jackson said his team has played tournaments in New Orleans and at Southwest Texas State University, in addition to intramural basketball at A&M.

"We won intramurals in 1997 but lost to our rival team this year," he said. "Most of the players on our rival team are graduating, so who knows what could happen next year."

Sanaz Khanbolooki, financial development executive for MSC Hospitality and a junior biochemistry major, said Slamfest was larger than she expected.

"We had to cancel last year because not enough teams signed up," she said. "So I was real excited to have so many teams this year and to have everything run smoothly."
