A Martina by any other name

Family ties bring freshman standout to Ag tennis team

The name Martina is synonymous with tennis greatness. Former No. 1 international player Martina Navratilova won a record nine Wimbledon singles championships. Current No. 1 Martina Hingis has amassed five Grand Slam singles titles. Continuing that tradition is Texas A&M freshman Martina Nedorostova, who compiled a sparkling 9-2 conference record this season to claim the title of Big 12 No. 1 Singles Champion.

Nedorostova, from Bratislava, Slovakia, is the first Aggie to win a No. 1 singles title since Vanne Akagi captured the Southwest Conference championship in 1986.

A&M women's tennis coach Bobby Kleinecke said several fortunate circumstances led to his signing of Nedorostova.

"Her sister was looking to transfer from Southeastern Louisiana (University), but she ended up deciding not to come," he said. "But she told me about her sister."

Nedorostova said her sister played a major role in the decision to attend A&M.

"I wanted her to pick the school for me," she said. "It was more important [to choose for] academics than athletics. We were supposed to come here together, but she changed her mind."

Nedorostova, currently ranked No. 66 in the national collegiate ten-

nis rankings, has used a powerful left-handed forehand to change the outcome of matches all season. After recording a 6-5 record in the fall, she played well this spring, finishing with a 17-5 record in dual matches.

"She is a very talented girl," Kleinecke said. "She can come up with the big shots when she needs them. She has improved a lot over the course of the year."

Others around the league are impressed with her game as well. Baylor University coach Dave Luedtke, whose Bears face the Aggies today in a Big 12 Tournament quarterfinal match at the A&M varsity Tennis Center, said Nedorostova's composure has been a key to the freshman's success.

"She's a very strong player," he said. "She holds herself well for a freshman and is very quick, along with her good forehand."

It was against Baylor on April 20 that Nedorostova won what she considers her most exciting match. Against the Bears' Katja Kovac, Nedorostova prevailed in a three-set thriller, 6-3, 3-6, 7-6 (8-6), coming from match-point down. Her win was crucial to the Aggies' 5-4 victory over the Bears.

"The crowd was amazing that day," she said. "It was a tough match."

Baylor is led at the plate by all-purpose player Mary Hess, who has handled first base, third base, left field and right field while driving in 29 runs with an impressive .362 batting average. As a team, the Bears are batting .261.

Stacey Allison and Chrystal Smith are the

probable Baylor starters for the weekend matchups. Allison leads the staff with a 15-10 record and a 2.15 ERA. The hurler also has put together two no-hitters this season while striking out 127 batters. Smith has put together a 9-3 record this season with a 3.04 ERA.

Sunday, the women head to Lubbock to close out their regular season with a pair against the Red Raiders. Tech sits at fifth in the conference with a 5-6 record, 30-26 overall.
