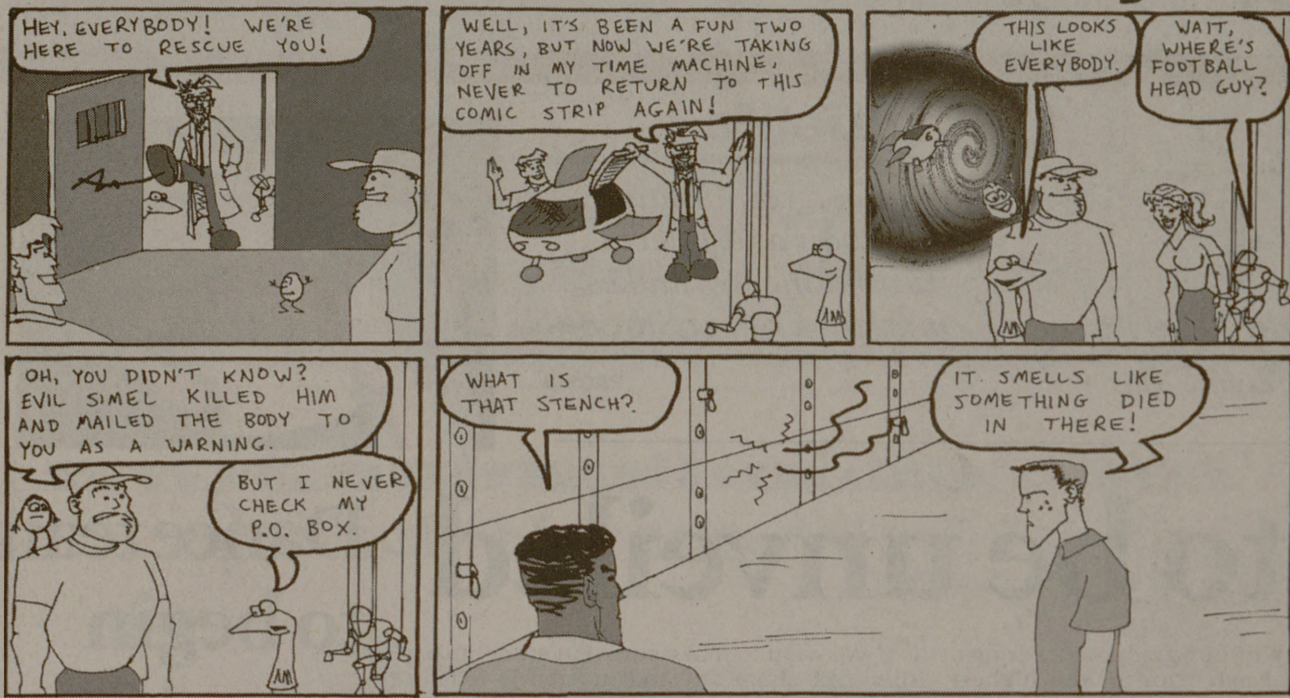

to carry higher amounts of traffic. Mike McMichen, a member of Friends of Our Community, said the city has been planning for the higher traffic counts for 40 years, and the plan should be carried out.  
"We believe Munson Avenue should be opened and possibly widened to handle the increase in traffic," McMichen said. "A proper study needs to be done to measure the traffic demands on Munson Avenue."  
Citizens for Neighborhood Integrity believes the preservation of the neighborhood is at stake. Members say the traffic is dangerous for children and will eventually lower the property values of the homes in the area.  
Miller said the vandalism and garbage he has seen in the neighborhood has become intolerable.
