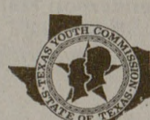

Madden ends season at NCAA's Sophomore reaches second round of tennis championships

A&M sophomore general studies major **Shuon Madden**, who finished the regular season with All-Big 12 honors and a singles record of 25-9, followed up his successful season with an at-large appearance in the NCAA Individual Tennis Championships.

The NCAA's, May 27 at the Dan Magill Tennis Complex on the University of Georgia, are the second tournament appearance

for the 22nd-ranked tennis player.

Madden faced off against **Mathieu Ballay** of Mississippi State University in the first round. Madden defeated Ballay, 6-3, 4-6, 6-2, to reach the second round.

A&M men's tennis coach **Tim Cass** said he was pleased with Madden's performance.

"Considering it's been two weeks since Shuon has played a match, he played well," Cass said.

Madden went on to play against eighth-seeded **Hisham Hemeda** of Georgia, who defeated

Madden, 6-4, 6-4.

"Shuon faced one of the top players in the nation today ... the guy's home court with a green field-street crowd behind him (Hemeda), Cass said.

Madden, who ended his season with a 26-10 singles record, was the first Aggie to make it to the second round of the tournament since **Mark Weaver** did it in 1997.

"Madden has had a great season individually and as a leader on our team," Cass said. "We can now look to next year and begin to set our team goals."

Avalanche take 3-2 lead over Stars

DALLAS (AP) — The Colorado Avalanche have this thing about adversity. They thrive on it.

Missing two of their top five scorers, the Avalanche erupted for their most goals of the playoffs Sunday in a 7-5 victory over the Dallas Stars in Game 5 of the Western Conference finals.

Colorado, which overcame an 0-2 deficit against two-time champion Detroit in the second round, is one victory from the Stanley Cup finals.

The Avalanche have their first shot at advancing Tuesday night in Denver. If a seventh game is needed, it will be Friday night in Dallas.

"I think we learned in the Detroit series that you're not going to win on talent alone," Colorado defenseman **Aaron Miller** said.

"But when we play together, we're a great team, a real force out there."

The Avalanche came to Dallas ready to play without rookie scoring sensation **Milan Hejduk** for the first time since he broke his collarbone Friday night. Then, a few hours before the game, they learned that second-leading scorer **Theo Fleury** had the flu and could not play.

The Stars could not take advantage of their absence, and they did not do much with leads of 2-1 or 3-2. Dallas did score twice within 1:15 in the third period to tie the game.

Playing 38 hours after Drury's overtime goal in Game 4 tied the

series, Colorado forced Dallas to play an up-tempo game. The Stars were waves of odd-man rushes against goaltender **Ed Belfour**.

Belfour, playing in his 10th playoff game, gave up two goals each period. He had only had two two-goal periods in his previous 72 periods this postseason.

The Stars made a game of again after **Valeri Kamensky**'s second goal gave the Avalanche a lead with 13:34 left.

A goal by **Mike Keane** that was waved off because he kicked the puck into the net. Dallas' 17,001 fans going wild erupted again when **Brett Hull** fired the puck past **Patrick Roy** to make it 5-4, and 1:15 later **Pat Verbeek** to tie the game with 9:03 left.

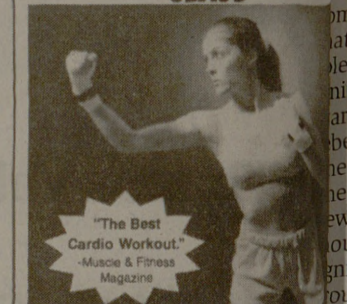
