Mental health question addressed by conference

woman said drugs for treating her manic depression once ate up half her family's income. A mother said it took three years to find the right specialist in Nashville, Tenn., for her son's mental problem.

Against a backdrop of such testimony, President Clinton asked Congress on Monday to ensure that Americans with mental illness get the same health benefits they now have for a broken leg or an asthma attack.

Without proper treatment for mental illness, he told a White House conference, "the loss of human potential is staggering."

The conference was led by Tipper Gore, Vice President Al Gore's wife, whose role in advising Clinton on mental illness took on a personal dimension when she recently disclosed she had suffered clinical depression after her son was hit by a car 10

Mental illness is "the last great stigma of the 20th century," she said, noting how cancer and then AIDS were once unmentionable in many families. "Most people treat someone with a mental illness as if it's their fault or as if they can just snap out of it."

The conference, drawing mental health professionals together here and in cities across the country who were linked electronically, focused on making people understand that mental illness is a sickness much like any other — "a real disease of a real organ, the brain," as one panelist put it — and that no one should feel shame or suffer discrimination for getting treatment.

Study: Cells may restore neuron rest

'Master cells' could reverse damage from disease, researchers In a

WASHINGTON (AP) Injections of neural stem cells, a so-called master cell that can mature into any type of brain tissue, may be able to restore neurons killed by Alzheimer's and other diseases that affect the whole brain, laboratory studies with mice suggest.

Dr. Evan Y. Snyder of Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston said the laboratory study shows that the neural stem cells will convert themselves into whatever type of cell the ailing brain needs, restoring functions that have been lost to disease, injury or birth defect.

"The neural stem cell has the ability to become a whole range of cell types in the brain," said Snyder, the lead author of a study appearing Tuesday in Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences. "The neural stem cell can accommodate all different

regions of the brain and insert itself appropriately into the fabric of the brain."
