Austin Powers: The Spy Who Shagged Me

Starring Mike Myers and Heather Graham
Playing at Hollywood 16

The summer's most anticipated comedy, *Austin Powers: The Spy Who Shagged Me*, promises a lot but delivers very little. It is still a hilariously clever portrayal of Britain's one and only "international man of mystery," but on the whole, the film is a disappointment that does nothing more than build upon the nostalgic original movie created.

Dr. Evil is back, and who better to stop him than the swinging gaelic man of mystery, Austin Powers.

This time, however, Powers (Myers) must overcome the more advanced and better prepared Dr. Evil (also Myers) who has created a time machine to go back to the '60s to steal Austin's mojo. This Evil hopes, will help him defeat his nemesis and take over the world.

Mike Myers, as always, does a fabulous job. Sadly, though, his timing and brilliance is not enough to cover up this movie's problems. For one, his new partner, Felicity Shagwell (Graham), is horrible. Everything but stealing the eyes of the audience. In fact, her performance is so bad it is almost offensive that the makers of such a blatantly original comedy could allow it.

The script also seemed to be too quickly thrown together, and humor most likely was worn out by its predecessor gets rather and lame as well.

Some highlights, though, include the hilarious portrayal of Dr. Evil as well as other comical references to the James Bond movies. The films have always sought to spoof.

Overall, this film is nothing more than a poor sequel to an incredibly successful original. It's disappointing, and has little to offer but proof that Britain's psychedelical, love-crazed man of mystery, Austin Powers, is just not clever enough to be carried over to a sequel. (Grade: D+)

Watching *Trekkiies* is like being taken through a carnival freak show.

Denise Crosby, who played Tasha Yar on "Star Trek: The Next Generation," is the guide through the unusual world of die-hard Star Trek fans.

From a family who dresses up as Klingons on a regular basis, a woman who goes to work in the outfit of a Federation officer complete with tactical belt, the movie views the hardcore fans in an objective manner.

The scariest story is of a woman who lives a few blocks away from Brent Spiner, who played Data on "Star Trek: The Next Generation." She obsesses over the actor to the point that she takes several nights to stare at his house in what she likes to call a "Brent Breach."

The film is entertaining and good therapy for someone who wants to feel like they're normal.

It also shows how much a simple TV show has impacted our American culture. (Grade: B+)
