Growing pains

Reform Party faces internal dissent

DEARBORN, Mich. (AP) — The Reform Party's palpable sense of confidence, fueled by the election of Minnesota Gov. Jesse Ventura, has become tempered by inside squabbling and power struggles.

Even the election of a new chairman could fuel dissent. Jack Gargan, chosen over two other hopefuls yesterday, has promised not to support another presidential run by Ross Perot.

The retired financial consultant from Florida also says he will move the party's headquarters from Perot's Dallas offices to Florida.

The party must weather such storms as part of its growth, said Pat Benjamin, vice chair of the party and one of the two people who ran against Gargan, as she watched a fight between New Jersey delegates.

"Each of these things is growing pains. At this stage, everything is important," said Benjamin, of Cherry Hill, N.J., who was second in the chair race. "This is democracy. It isn't pretty today."

The party's lack of unity is of great concern, said Gargan, who won Ventura's endorsement in the balloting to succeed outgoing party chair Russ Verney.

Fewer delegates came to this year's convention than in two years, Gargan said. Of the 585 delegates slated for the Reform Party's convention, and the party losing ballot access in states, he said.

Gargan said the state party was the reason he left the chair.

"I don't want the damage that I've got too much at stake," said Gargan. "I have so much at stake not about to let this thing slide."

The Reform Party's success may stem in part from the party's welcoming of people who want change and are dissatisfied by other parties. It has so many different kinds of delegates, that it is hard to develop a message.

"We have everyone from the WWF as people who think Jesse Jackson is a conservative to people who think Pat Buchanan is too liberal. We have Tom McLaughlin, the Pennsylvania state chair, and third candidate on the chair race."

McLaughlin estimated there are eight to 10 candidates within the party. He said the party can be unified as its platform sticks to economic issues like balancing the budget, reducing the national debt and campaign finance reform. Social issues should be left to the individual candidates to decide, he said.

Mass remembered JFK Jr., Bessette

WASHINGTON (AP) — An estimated 4,500 people gathered yesterday at a huge Catholic church in the nation's capital to pay respects to John F. Kennedy Jr., Carolyn Kennedy Bessette and Lauren Bessette.

The mass honoring the trio killed in an airplane crash July 16 was held at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception.

Kennedy "was a symbol of a generation coming into its own," said the Rev. William E. Lori, Auxiliary Bishop of Washington. "He revered his famous father, shared the life of his famous family, yet carved out a path all his own," Lori said. "Carolyn and Lauren, while not so completely in the spot-

light, were women of accomplishment in their own right."

Eleanor Holmes Norton, D.C., of Columbia's nonvoting delegate to the House of Representatives said she came to the mass because Washington "in many ways is Kennedy territory."

"Not just John F. Kennedy, but this family changed this town," Norton said. "They came from a Southern town — not just a cosmopolitan. When they left a world-class city, they left a world-class city."

Also attending was the city's mayor, Anthony Williams. "Our city represents much a national service, as on the local level," Williams said. "John Kennedy contributed to that tradition."

Handyman arrested in Yosemite murder

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (AP) — A hotel maintenance man was arrested in the beheading of a naturalist at Yosemite National Park and is a suspect in the killings of three park sightseers earlier this year, the FBI said yesterday.

Cary Stayner was accused of killing Joie Ruth Armstrong, 26, whose decapitated body was found near her Yosemite housing on Thursday. The 38-year-old man was arrested Saturday at a nudist colony and is expected to be arraigned today on a charge of murder in a national park, the FBI said.

Stayner, who was questioned at the time of the three previous slayings but ruled out as a suspect, is now believed to have played a role in those crimes, said Special Agent in Charge James M. Maddock. The bodies of Carole Sund, her daughter Juli, and family friend Silvina Pelosso of Argentina were discovered in March.

"We have developed good information linking Stayner to the Sund-Pelosso murders," Maddock said.

The Stayner name already is indelibly etched in the annals of California crime.

His brother, Steven Stayner, was a sexually abused kidnap victim who was abducted from Merced street in 1972. The boy was reunited with his family years later. But as if his short life under a cloud, Stayner died in 1989 in a collision with a hit-and-run driver.

Cary Stayner was last seen Thursday night by friends and coworkers at the Cedar Lodge Portal, where he works as a handyman.

He was taken into custody by federal authorities Saturday morning at a nudist colony in a park near Sacramento, after a man recognized him from news reports and called authorities.
