ROME, N.Y. (AP) — Although toilets, overturn a car and Woodstock '99 ended in fires, looting, vandalism and police being pelted with bottles and fruit, officials said the destruction was caused by a small segment of the concertgoers.

"This festival did not collapse into chaos," Oneida County Executive Ralph Eannace said during a news conference Monday. "This festival had a very serious problem for a few hours last night.

Local officials refused to call Sunday's episode at the three-day not collapse festival a riot. Two state troopinto chaos." ers were among seven people injured in the melee before authorities regained control

of the festival just before daybreak Monday. One concertgoer suffered a broken leg and back injuries.

Seven people were arrested on charges of rioting, disorderly conduct and criminal mischief. The chaos involved a few hundred youths from among a crowd of about 150,000 at the time, State Police Superintendent James McMahon said.

Those caught on the festival grounds at the former military base had a much different perspective as they watched an unruly mob loot and burn a row of 12 tractor trailers, set fire to a small bus and several portable
