'This disease grows so very rapidly that if you fail to kill all the cancer with chemotherapy, it doesn't come back years later, Einhorn said. "It comes back months later. When a patient is one year cancer-free after chemotherapy, he has a 95 percent probability of a cure.' Now, 2 1/2 years later, his


