Rumours marks reopening

Rumours Deli, which has a colorful history on the Texas A&M campus and has served thousands of students including Lyle Lovett, will celebrate its grand reopening with new renovations through Wednesday in the MSC.

Student Body President Will Hurd said he wanted to have a place on campus where students could study, socialize, stay after-hours and be able to grab a quick bite to eat.

"Two years ago, I was on the Basement task force. We wanted to make sure the students were able to use the MSC efficiently and also to see if the MSC was running effectively," Hurd said. "Revitalizing Rumours was included in this discussion. Basically, we wanted an on-campus, late-night, coffee-shop place for students to study and have food and drinks accessible to them."

Hurd said this is a great achievement and is an additional service the MSC offers to the A&M community including the state of the art audio-video equipment.

"The entire project, including a 42-inch plasma screen and a DVD stereo system, cost around \$80,000," Hurd said.

Jack Cahill, the division manager for Cash Operations, said prices will be lower than competing student hang-outs.

"We make sure that we are below the prices of Starbucks, Sweet Eugene's and other coffee shops. We want to be the cheapest place in town."

Pat Hurst, Rumours Deli and Hullabaloo manager, said he encourages students and groups to come in and meet in the evenings to socialize and study.

Hurst said, the new menu is also scheduled for student entertainment, Hurd said.

"The inside is completely renovated," Hurd said. "We added lighting and sports, an upgraded sound system, furniture, new carpet, and menu items were all added."

In the afternoon evenings there will be a featuring new appetizers.

"Breakfast is served from 7 a.m. to 2 a.m. Our coffee bar will be available to students," Hurd said.

Mandy Leks, a junior major and cell biology major, is looking forward to seeing Rumours Deli as a place to socialize.

"Rumours will be a great place for me and my friends to go and relax," she said. "I really like the idea of having a place on campus that will be open until serving food and drinks, convenient location and atmosphere is much better than before the renovation."

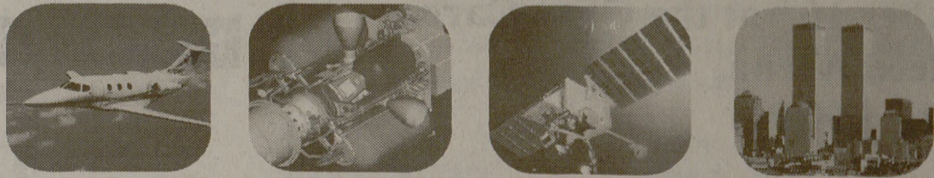
