Diana's necklace revealed for auction

NEW YORK (AP) — The stunning 178-diamond and pearl necklace Princess Diana wore at her last official engagement was unveiled yesterday prior to an auction.

The piece, along with a pair of matching earrings that were made for Diana but never worn, is set to be auctioned Dec. 16 by the New York-based auction house Guernsey's.

Arlan Ettinger, president of Guernsey's, said the set is the only jewelry worn by the princess likely to be sold because the rest of her jewels are owned by her family or the British crown.

Princess Diana wore the necklace to The Royal Gala Performance of Swan Lake at the Royal Albert Hall on June 3, 1997.

She died in a car crash in Paris nearly three months later.

It was made by the crown jeweler, an English firm known as Garrard, which has since joined with another company to form Asprey & Garrard's.

In the months before her death, the princess returned the necklace to Garrard's so the earrings could be made.

The royal family eventually decided to have Garrard's sell the pieces to benefit Diana's memorial fund.

Bobbitt receives probation for theft

FALLON, Nev. (AP) — John Wayne Bobbitt escaped jail time on a larceny charge but was sentenced to five years of probation yesterday by a judge who said he was glad to get Bobbitt out of town.

Bobbitt, who became famous in 1993 when his then-wife, Lorena, cut off his penis, pleaded guilty in May to stealing clothing from a Fallon store.

He could have been sentenced to up to five years in prison and fined \$10,000.

Churchill County District Judge Archie Blake also ordered Bobbitt to pay \$5,000 restitution and serve 100 hours of community service.

Bobbitt moved to Fallon in 1997 and worked at a brothel near Carson City.

Twice, he was accused of beat-

ing up a former topless dancer who was his fiancée while he was living in Las Vegas.

Lately, he has been living in upstate New York, where he says he is trying to start a new career as a comedian.

He said he would do his community service there, possibly as a volunteer firefighter.

The judge said he was concerned about Bobbitt serving that part of the sentence so far away, but added: "Quite frankly, I'd rather have him out of this community. New York seems like a good place."

Bobbitt told the judge he got involved with the wrong kinds of people.

"I got caught up in my own personal greed until my conscience told me better," he said.

McCarthy marries director John Asher

BEVERLY HILLS, Calif. (AP) — Actress Jenny McCarthy married director John Asher at the Beverly Hills Hotel.

The ceremony took place Saturday, McCarthy's publicist, Susan Dubow, said.

The two are on their honeymoon this week.

McCarthy, 26, met Asher on the set of his film *Diamonds*, starring Kirk Douglas.

Diamonds, to be released early 2000 by Miramax, cast McGlas as a former boxer recovering from a stroke.

McCarthy, a former *Playmate* and host of the game show "Singed Out," was in the short-lived NBC sitcom "Parker" and had a role opposite Parker and Matt Stone in the edgy *BASEketball*.

Tarzan honored historical marker

WINDBER, Pa. (AP) — The man had some mountain roots.

A historical marker for Johnny Weissmuller, one of the first movie Tarzans and Olympic gold medalist in boxing, was dedicated Monday in Windber, about 60 miles east of Pittsburgh.

The star of a string of black and white *Tarzan* films lived only a few miles from the town in the Allegheny Mountains.

He was born in Freidorf, Austria, in 1904 and later moved to Windber, then a coal mining town. They moved to Chicago in 1908.
