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gency. Public schools were closed in Washington, Baltimore, all of New Jersey, Philadelphia and New York City — a part of the country more accustomed to snow days.

New York's mass transit system proved vulnerable to rain just three weeks ago. A freak storm during the morning rush hour dumped 3 inches of rain, halting subway trains and disrupting commuter rail service. Hundreds of thousands of workers got to work late or not at all.

The storm shut commuter rail service north of Manhattan, temporarily trapping roughly 15,000 commuters who had not joined the early rush out of the city. Limited service was restored a few hours later.

The New York Stock Exchange stuck to regular hours, but the U.N. Security Council postponed a meeting on protecting civilians in war zones. U.N. officials said it was the first time in recent history that a formal, open meeting of the Security Council was derailed by bad weather.


