Roland said he is indifferent to the materials posted.

Jeff McCabe, associate director of the Texas A&M Computing Information Services (CIS), said it provides the technical services for ResNet to students, much like GTE provides telephone services to students.

"ResNet is supported by CIS only technically," McCabe said. "It's not really a CIS issue, although if someone reports something illegal or against Texas A&M rules and regulations, it will be dealt with according to Texas A&M policy."

McCabe said if students find offensive material, they can report it to CIS through an online complaint form.

Roland said the fact that the network is University affiliated probably will not stop students from posting inappropriate materials.

"I don't know if they've cracked down on it," Roland said. "But there's always a way to get around it."

Sex, however, is not limited to virtual reality or private quarters around campus. From students trying to escape their dorm rooms to those into adventurous study breaks, many areas of campus have seen a bit of action.

Ryan Allain, a senior mechanical engineering major, said several students he knows have found more unique places to have sex around campus.
