

## SPORTS IN BRIEF

### Volleyball takes on Missouri Tigers in Big 12 opener at G. Rollie White Coliseum tonight at 7 against the University of Missouri.

The No. 16 Texas A&M Volleyball Team (9-1, 0-0) will open Big 12 Conference play at G. Rollie White Coliseum tonight at 7 against the University of Missouri.

The Aggies lead the all-time season with Missouri, 8-1, and have won the last seven meetings.

A&M is 11-6 all-time in conference openers, including 2-1 since Big 12 play began.

Led by tournament MVP Woolsey, A&M is coming off of consecutive tournament appearances after winning its own Volleyball Classic last week.

The Aggies swept Sam Houston State, the University of Georgia and the University of Georgia to extend their game-winning streak to a record 26 games.

Missouri went 1-2 at a tournament hosted by the University of Arkansas, including a 2-0 loss to the No. 20 Razorbacks in the final match.

The match is the first in the history of the volleyball program.

## Gailey admits he blew free-kick catch

IRVING (AP) — Dallas Cowboys coach Chan Gailey admitted Tuesday that he goaded by not requesting a free kick after a fair catch on the final play of the first half against the Atlanta Falcons.

Gailey said he knew of the rule that gives coaches the option of trying an uncontested field goal after any fair catch, but he figured that only was possible if there was time remaining.

So when he saw 0:00 on the clock after punt returner Wade McCarthy's fair catch at the end of the second quarter Monday night, Gailey took his team to the locker room.

"I'm always cognizant of being able to do it because I've always wanted to do it," Gailey said. "I had a chance and I missed it."

## Defense steps up for 'Boys against Falcons'

IRVING (AP) — Payback arrived quickly in the Dallas Cowboys locker room.

A week after being bailed out by the offense, the Dallas defense returned the favor Monday night in a 24-7 victory over Atlanta.

Against the Falcons, the guys who allowed Washington to put up 504 yards and 35 points in the opener set up 10 of Dallas' first 17 points with an interception and a fumble.

Then, when they started to slip in the final minutes, giving Atlanta at least a glimmer of hope, the defense roared back when Greg Ellis returned an interception 87 yards for a game-sealing touchdown.

"Last week we were proud of our offense for coming back and winning the game," Ellis said. "But we knew we didn't play well defensively and we wanted to come out and make a statement."

Dallas joined Detroit as the NFC's only 2-0 teams. It is the best start for the Cowboys since their last Super Bowl season, 1995, and they get an extra week to savor it as they have a bye this Sunday.

When Dallas returns Oct. 3 at home against Arizona, the secondary could have a new and improved look. Deion Sanders' gimpy left big toe will likely be ready for action and there is a decent chance Kevin Smith will be ready to test his aching back.

The Cowboys managed three interceptions without them Monday and had a Sanders-like 154 yards in returns. Amazingly, Ellis, linebacker Dexter Coakley and safety Izell Reese combined for more yards than the Dallas offense had on the ground (133) or in the air (98).

The Cowboys had just 231 yards of offense, less than half the 541 they gained against the Redskins in a 41-35 overtime victory. Then again, they did not need much as their three scoring drives went 4, 60 and 26 yards.
