Ryder Cup back in U possession

BROOKLINE, Mass. All Ben Crenshaw and Ryder Cup team to believe, and the Am responded with a charged simply unbelievable.

With a birdie putt that long as America's chances Leonard took dead aim in Ryder Cup history, at the 17-inch gold chalice on U.S. soil for the first since 1993.

Victory came on the green, across the street where Francis Ouimet led him won the 1913 U.S. Open-made golf popular in the States. This triumph made out of a U.S. team that aside the dispute over money won something that proved far more valuable.

"I never stopped believing," choked-up Crenshaw said. 14 1/2-13 1/2 victory stunned. This is so incredible. Leonard's 45-foot birdie unleashed a torrent of emotion that had been building out an electric day at The Club, where fans cheered American victory and missed putt by the European.

Although one match was on the course, the putt followed by Jose Maria Olazagaberris guaranteed Americans 14 1/2 points, amount they needed to win an amount few believed would get.

"This was history being made today, and we all wanted to be part of that," Hal Sutton, rock-solid star of the U.S. team, who contributed 3 1/2 points said. "This is the greatest moment in golf right now."

Despite a 10-6 deficit going into the final round, despite the fact no team has ever come back from more than two points in the last day, Crenshaw refused to give up. "I'm a big believer," he warned Saturday night, "I'll warn his finger with a wink. 'Believe it!'"

Those were fitting words Crenshaw, who won the Masters after the death of longtime teacher Harvey Penick's spirit guiding him.

In much the same way Crenshaw willed his team to victory on this course, which has long history of U.S. victories. "It's all because of the Crenshaw," Davis Love III said. "He fired us up, made us believe we could do it."
