

LOS ANGELES (AP) — NFL great Jim Brown was sentenced yesterday to three years of probation and ordered to take domestic violence counseling for smashing his wife's car with a shovel during an argument that led her to

Brown also must pay \$1,500 to a battered women's shelter and another \$200 to a domestic violence fund. The 63-year-old Hall of Famer, who was not in court, was told to

appear Oct. 20 with proof that he

had joined a counseling program. Brown's lawyer told Municipal Court Judge Dale Fischer that his client opposed any sentencing that included domestic violence conditions. He noted that a jury found Brown guilty only of misdemeanor vandalism on Sept. 10, acquitting him of a charge that he made a terrorist threat against

"It's unfair to put any conditions of domestic violence on a man who's been actually found not guilty of domestic violence, lawyer William Graysen said outside court.
