



# After Stella, actor Taye Diggs grapples with sum

NEW YORK (AP) — It does not take much to figure out why Taye Diggs makes women swoon.

Just one look at his smooth, unblemished skin usually does it. Or his taut, lean muscular body. Or that steamy shower scene in How Stella Got Her Groove Back.

As he relaxes in a pinstriped suit in a midtown hotel the bespectacled Diggs professes not to understand what it is about him that makes women so hot and bothered.

"I try to intellectualize it, and you can't. A lot of it is the fact is that I don't feel like I'm worth someone screaming about," said one of People magazine's 50 Most Beautiful people.
