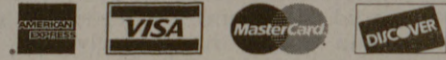

Changes prevalent in series
ATLANTA (AP) — A changed since the Yankees last came south World Series. The old stadium is just a parking lot now, with painted lines where the basepaths used to be. Jimmy Key and Cecil Fielder are out of baseball. Mark Wohlers and Marquis Grimes are out of Atlanta. "I don't think we'll spend a lot of time looking at what's the difference between now and 1996," Braves' Tom Glavine said yesterday. Glavine will start against Orlando "El Duque" Hernandez, MVP of the AL Championship Series, in Game 1 Saturday at Turner Field. The addresses have moved and so have the attitudes into a rematch of the '96 won by New York in six games. "That team wasn't as good as we thought they were," pitcher David Cone of 11 Yankees left from said. "We had never seen before. Now we have the chance to know what we can do." First baseman Tim Lincecum said: "That year we were underdogs. We wanted to win but this year we expected to." Chipper Jones is one of eight Braves still remaining. "We're a lot closer to being a lot of adversity," the baseman said. "We didn't have that season after our first two games of the Series at New York. Back in the final three games of Atlanta-Fulton County Series they lost three in a row Yankees.
