## Clinton focuses on Mideast during Oslo visit

OSLO, Norway (AP) — Entering a fateful year would genuinely help to build a lasting peace in Middle East peacemaking, President Clinton the Middle East." in Middle East peacemaking, President Clinton offered strong encouragement yesterday and perhaps even Camp David-style negotiations to help Israel and the Palestinians resolve "the really hard part" of their decades-old conflict.

"I wouldn't rule out anything," Clinton said. "There is nothing I would not do if I thought it

The president met separately with Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Barak and Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat on the eve of a three-way meeting among them.

Arafat and Barak planned two hours of talks yesterday to set the stage.

The leaders gathered in the northern European country of glaciers and fjords to pay tribute to late Israeli Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin, assassinated four years ago by an Israeli opponent of the peace process. At a memorial dinner, Rabin's widow Leah challenged Barak and Arafat to "find the right formula to finish what my husband started and had to pay the highest price for - his life."


