## Peacekeepers upset by lack of cooperation between armies

DILI, East Timor (AP) — The head of the international peace-keeping force in East Timor said yesterday he is frustrated that Indonesia's army has failed to heed his appeal for high-level coordination between the two forces.

All Indonesian troops have left East Timor, but many are still based in neighboring West Timor, an Indonesian territory.

The peacekeepers and Indonesian army need to cooperate to avoid misunderstandings and to facilitate the return of refugees from West Timor, Australian Maj. Gen. Peter Cosgrove said.

Indonesian military officials in West Timor were not immediately available for comment, and military officials in Jakarta referred requests for comment to West Timor.

Cosgrove said he has been trying to talk with the Indonesian army commander in West Timor, Gen. Damyri, since mid-October. In the absence of any contact, he said, he has authorized lower-level contacts between the two sides at the border.

Indonesia occupied East Timor, a former Portuguese colony, in 1975.

It has ceded control to the United Nations, which is expected to administer East Timor during a two- to three-year transition to independence. The last Indonesian troops left the territory Sunday.

Australia is leading the multinational force that entered East Timor on Sept. 20.

An overwhelming vote for independence three weeks earlier sparked a rampage by pro-Jakarta militias and their Indonesian army backers.

Militia members fled to West Timor after peacekeepers arrived, and some had threatened to return to East Timor and reclaim control. Cosgrove said no clashes have been reported between peacekeepers and militia members along the border for several weeks.

East Timor had a population of 800,000 before the election violence. Cosgrove said today his best estimate of the number of East Timorese still unaccounted for is 80,000.

## China charges 6 members of Falun Gong movement

### Banned sect

Chinese prosecutors have formally charged six members of the Falun Gong spiritual movement with crimes. Since banning Falun Gong July 22, Chinese authorities have pursued a relentless campaign of vilification against the group's U.S.-based founder, Li Hongzhi. Here is a brief look at the movement.

### FOLLOWERS

The movement has proved widely popular with middle-aged and older Chinese people, including Communist Party members. Falun Gong claims 100 million believers worldwide, most of them in China. The Communist Party puts the total in China at 2 million.

### ORIGIN

Li Hongzhi, a former soldier-trumpeter and government clerk in northeastern China, he learned Falun Gong from a spiritual master he has never identified. The Chinese government blames him for the deaths of people by brainwashing the shunning medical care.

### BELIEFS

An offshoot of traditional slow motion exercise philosophies believed to channel unseen natural forces through the body, Falun Gong blends concepts drawn from Buddhism and Taoism. These practices are used to promote health and more

## U.S. fighter planes attack Iraqi anti-aircraft sites after coming under

ANKARA, Turkey (AP) — U.S. warplanes attacked Iraqi air-defense sites yesterday after coming under fire during routine patrols of the northern Iraq no-fly zone, the U.S. military said.

The planes targeted an Iraqi artillery site northwest of Bashiqah and north of Tall Afar, the Germany-based U.S. European Command said in a statement.

Tall Afar is 250 miles north of Baghdad, and

Bashiqah is 42 miles farther east.

The jets, based in Incirlik in southern Turkey, left the area safely, the statement said. Incirlik spokesperson Lt. Col. Mike Waters refused to specify the type of ordnance dropped.

"They were weapons we felt best dealt with the situation," Waters said.

U.S. forces lately have been using concrete bombs against Iraqi targets to minimize pos-

sible harm to civilians.

U.S. and British planes have been patrolling no-fly zones over northern and southern Iraq since the end of the 1991 Persian Gulf War. The zones were set up to protect Kurds and Shiites from forces of Iraqi President Saddam Hussein.

Iraq said the zones are a violation of international law and has frequently challenged U.S. planes there since December.
