Running back Eric Bernard injured his shoulder against Nebraska but is expected to Saturday against Missouri.

Wide receiver Chris Taylor (sprained right knee) and defensive end Rocky Bernard (sprained ankle) are listed as questionable for Saturday's game.

Defensive back Jeremy Weisinger is considered doubtful with a neck injury.

Outside linebacker Christian Rodriguez (sprained left knee) and tight end Michael de la Torre (back injury) — both listed as doubtful — will not play Saturday, Slocum said.

Offensive tackle Shea Hollis is out for the season with a right anterior cruciate ligament injury.

'Boys face life without Triplets'

IRVING (AP) — The Dallas Cowboys always knew one day they would be without their big stars on offense. After 152 regular-season games, it looks like that day will be Sunday.

Troy Aikman, Emmitt Smith and Michael Irvin are expected to miss the same game for the first time since becoming teammates in 1990. Injuries ranging from flu-like to career-threatening will force the so-called triplets to wear street clothes when Dallas plays Green Bay at Texas Stadium.

With Deion Sanders also being bling, the Cowboys (4-4) could be headed toward a last season. They have already lost four of their five games, blowing leads of 17 and 10 points.

"Nobody wants to hear about injuries," Dallas center Stephen Stepnoski said. "But when you look around the huddle — Aikman, Emmitt Smith, Mike Daryl Johnston aren't there. A lot of weapons aren't with the guys out, we are kind of short on blanks."

Irvin has been out for a while with a neck injury that led to the discovery of a genetic condition that could force him to retire. Aikman and Smith were on the Monday night in a 27-17 loss to Minnesota.

A third-quarter sack left Irvin with a concussion, his second injury in eight days and his second concussion in 11 seasons. Irvin broke the bone behind the knuckle on his right ring finger when his hand got stuck in a mask of a player he was tackling on a long touchdown run.

Doctors were conservative in putting pin in Smith's hand, had not decided as of yesterday afternoon. Cowboys coach Wade Gilbert said he expects the running back to miss at least two weeks.

"I've been carrying the burden of my life and I can't ever remember breaking a bone," Smith, who has been on his way to a 140-yard night after gaining 140 yards in two touchdowns on 13 carries.

Although Gilbert said Irvin has not yet been ruled out of Sunday's game, the quarter-back agent, Leigh Steinberg, said he doesn't strike me as being a probability that he'd play suffering two head injuries in eight days."

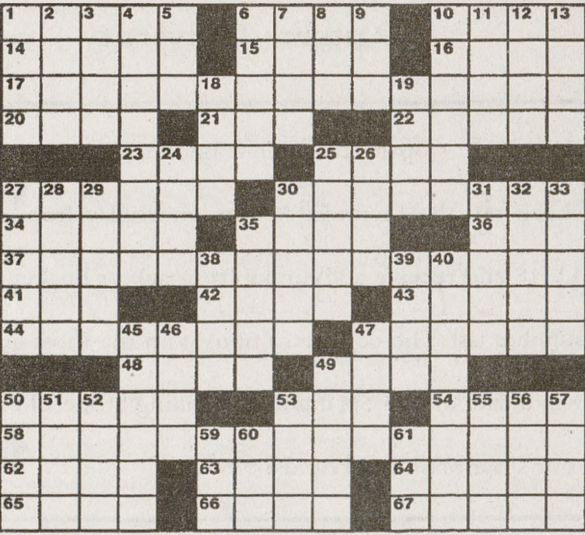
