Volleyball team take on Sooners

The Texas A&M Volleyball team will be in Big 12 action this week in Norman, Okla. when it takes on the University of Oklahoma Sooners. Match time is set for 7 p.m.

The Aggies (20-5, 11-4 Big 12) are in a three-way tie for second place with the University of Texas and State University, Nebraska, alone in first place.

Oklahoma holds an 8-1 all record and is in 10th place a 3-12 Big 12 Conference. In 1998, the Sooners led the season at 10-22 and 10th in the conference with a 16 record.

The two teams squared earlier this season, and Aggies defeated the Sooners 7, 15-10, 15-5, at G. Rollie White Coliseum.

A&M holds the all-time lead over the Sooners, 16-1. The Aggies will be in action when they host 17th-ranked State at 7 p.m.
