uncontrollably and hugging their friends as they feared the worst. Animosity was turned on local police monitoring the barracudas and news reporters taking footage of the accident. Shouts of "go home" and "this isn't a Kodak moment" could be

A large body of students stood on the west end of the police perimeter, ready to go into the accident scene and help remove logs.

Local officials at first kept all students outside the lines, but needing more manpower, they let teams of 20 workers at a time remove logs not in the area of the collapse.

Despite the cold and early hour, the thoughts of four to five thousand students seemed focused on the most important thing — the safety of those still trapped beneath the collapsed pile.
