Harriers finish 2nd at NCAA tournament

The Texas A&M Men's Country Team, making its team appearance at the meet since 1982, finished Monday at the Championships in Bloomington, Ind. Senior Scott Lengele led the way for the Aggies, clocking a time of 30:54.40 around the 10,000-meter course to 14th — the highest finish for Aggie at the national meet school history.

Senior forward Kera Alexander junior guard Tina Jones are the Aggies' key players this year. The team has begun to adapt this season, since three of its starters have been the court with injuries.

Volleyball team to finish regular season Saturday

The 14th-ranked Texas Volleyball Team will head to last two matches of regular season play when it travels to the University of Colorado at Boulder, Colo., Wednesday and returns to G. Rollie White Coliseum to battle Iowa State University on Saturday. Wednesday's match will begin at 7 p.m., and Saturday's match will start at 4 p.m.

The Aggies (23-5, 14-4) remain in a tie for second place in the conference with the University of Texas.

Colorado (17-10, 11-1) is tied for fifth place in the conference with Baylor University. Baylor defeated Colorado earlier in the season at G. Rollie White, 16-15, 15-17.

Iowa State (2-23, 0-18) sits alone at 11th place in the 12 Conference. The Aggies' victory over the Cyclones, 15-1, 15-6, when they battled earlier this year in Ames, Iowa.

Seniors Celia Howes, Leahy, Summer Strickland, Amber Woolsey will be recognized prior to the Iowa State game because it is their last A&M game.

QB Aikman to return to Miami game

IRVING, Texas (AP) — QB Aikman, headache-free and dazed that he is not prone to concussions, will return to the Cowboys for Thursday's game against the Miami Dolphins.

Aikman went through light drills with the team Monday for the first time since Nov. 8, when a sack against Minnesota left him with a second concussion in eight days.

He has missed two games of precaution and has used the off to visit specialists.

"I think we've been very good with it," Aikman said. "I'm able to work out the past few days feel pretty good. It would be a Sunday ballgame, confident everything is OK."

Aikman, who turned 33 Sunday, was especially concerned about the hit that caused the second concussion was not as hard as the one, yet symptoms such as headaches and dizziness were worse.

Part of the cumulative concussions is that they are frequent and the side effects last longer. Aikman has had eight concussions in his 11-year career.

But the doctors he saw told him that those numbers were that bad.

The specialists said they've seen NFL players who have suffered 30-40 concussions in years.
