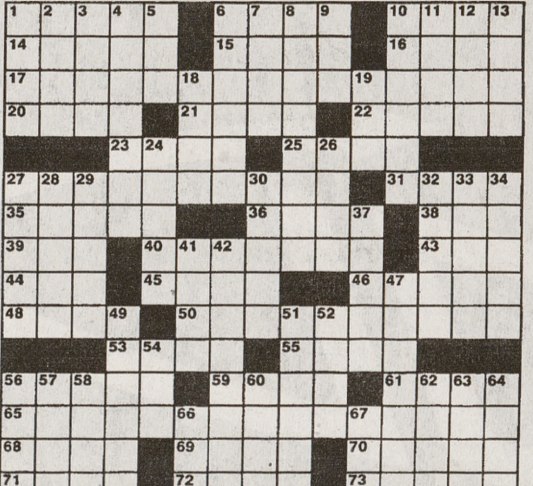

Women hoops face ex-SWC

The Texas A&M Basketball Team (2-0, 0-0 Big 12) will take to the road for the first time this season — taking with it the Aggies' best start since the 1995-1996 season — when they face the Southern Methodist Mustangs (3-0, 0-0 WAC) at 7 at Moody Coliseum. A&M is one of three Big 12 teams, The Aggies, Kansas (3-0) and Texas (0) atop the current league all standings. For the Aggies, it marks the first time since the formation of the Big 12 that they have opened their season opener with a 2-0 record. Led by junior guard Jones' 19.0 points a rebound and a transfer forward Saunders and her 18.5 points a game, the average 97.5 points a game. Jones recorded the career double-double tallied 17 points a rebound against Sam Houston State University in the 92-62 win. Junior transfer guard Jones barely missed the first A&M triple-double in 1990s when she scored 10 rebounds and assists in the game. The Mustangs, the Western Athletic Conference champions, are led by senior guard Karlin Kennedy with 19.7 points and 10.0 rebounds a game. The Aggies last best performance was a 100-87 victory over Sam Houston State University and Texas-Pan American. "This is a great honor," A&M women's coach Peggie Saunders said. "She adds so much to the team and can play nearly any position. She's another Aggie of how the depth of this has changed." Selected last month as the league's Preseason Newcomer of the Year, Saunders scored game-high 21 points versus Houston and grabbed seven rebounds. Then, in the Aggies' victory against UTPA, she scored 20 points, had six rebounds and seven assists.
