Lawrence said the University Press is in a consortium of nine other university presses including Texas Christian, Baylor Universities, warehouse sale including published by faculty in general of the consortium.

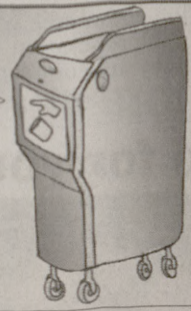
