Alamo Bowl year highest rated game

an honorable mention All-American. As a junior he averaged 11.4 points per game. But it was in the other half of the point guard, that Gilchrist's attention.

He was heavily recruited for defensive abilities and ball handling. Add to that nearly 10 assists and steals-per-game and Gilchrist had the makings of a well-rounded, threat guard.

"I could always score but I couldn't defend myself," he said. "I think I do a little bit of everything."

Gilchrist's performance on the court led up to preseason expectations while his offense added a much-needed bonus. The point guard leads the team with 30 steals while also contributing 8.5 points and 3.7 assists per game.

King was a different story. From start he knew he would be expected to score big. Coming out of high school ranked as the 33rd best prospect in the country by Bob Gibson's All-Report, he is one of the Aggies' highest-rated recruits ever. His senior he posted 28.9 points, 8.3 rebounds, 11.2 assists, 5.4 steals and 3.7 assists per-game on the way to earning Louisiana Mr. Basketball honors.

Since he has come to A&M, he has not let up on his performance. An early struggle to adjust to the college game, he quickly jumped into team lead in scoring with 16.3 points-per-game while also putting up numbers in the assists, steals and rebounding categories.

However his main contribution comes outside the arc. In 15 games, he has hit 40 three-pointers.

"Bernard had an off shooting streak against us, but you can tell from film that he's going to be an outstanding player," Williams said.

The two guards look to lead the team through this season's build-up period into a strong future led by a team of experienced players.

"I see this team as Top 25 soon," King said.

The success of that future will depend on if Gilchrist and King continue to dominate the backcourt while Watkins builds a supporting cast to the depth and consistency top team.
