 bidding can push the price of a film as high as \$10 million, beyond the box-office potential of most independent films. Artisan Entertainment had no competition for *Blair Witch*, the story of three filmmakers who vanished while hunting for a legendary witch. After seeing the movie at a midnight screening at Sundance, Artisan snapped it up, along with sequel rights, the next day. The success of *Blair Witch* had as

much to do with its gimmicky marketing as its gimmicky storytelling. Artisan's Internet-heavy campaign pitched the fictional movie as a documentary about real filmmakers whose story is told through their own footage, recovered a year after they disappeared in the woods. Some Hollywood executives have

observed that if a major studio had picked up *Blair Witch*, it might never have made back its million. Rather than risking the sort of guerrilla-marketing campaign Artisan concocted, a top studio likely would have plugged the film through traditional advertising that might not have captivated the youthful, computer-

savvy movie goers who made *Blair Witch* a megahit. *Blair Witch* was a marketing son's dream," Amir Malin, Artisan president, said. "It provided us ample opportunities to promote it get it out of the art-house ghetto find a commercial audience." Neil Friedman, a sales agent, said independent filmmakers should not head into the festival with unrealistic expectations that their movies be the next *Blair Witch*.
