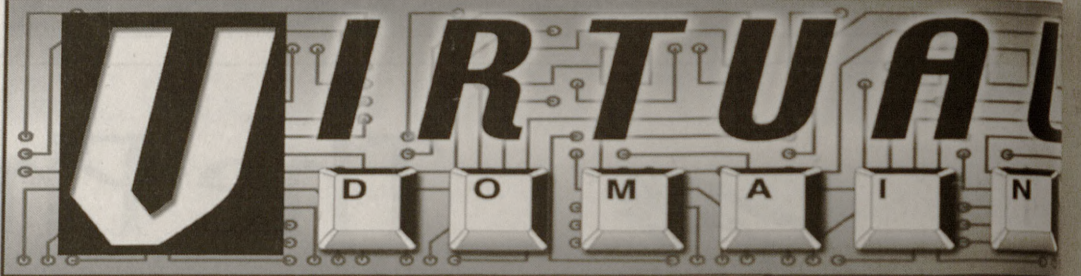

Super Smash Brothers incorporates many classic characters from the world of Nintendo and has them kick the living crap out of each other. From Mario to Link to Pikachu, the characters video game freaks know and love are here to beat on each other to no end.

There is a four-person multiplayer and not much skill is required. Each time a player is hit, his or her damage meter goes up and the character is easier to throw around. A player is killed when he or she falls off the play window.

Characters have special attacks that match their personalities. For example, Yoshi can swallow an opponent, pass the opponent through his intestinal tract, then excrete the opponent encased in a polka-dotted egg shell in approximately 1.2 seconds. Items are also found on the level to help 'smash' the opponent.

Secret characters are also available in the game, including a marshmallow-like creature named Jiggly Puff. Nothing beats pummeling a warrior like Samus (Metroid) or Link (Zelda) with a cute marshmallow with a bow named Jiggly Puff.

This game is a great way to pass the time with cutesy cartoon violence. (Grade: A)

NBA Basketball 2000 is a good video game but it has a few drawbacks. Designed to be totally authentic, NBA Basketball includes all NBA teams with team rosters updated as of August when the game was created.

Featuring the voices of Greg Pappas and Doc Rivers, commentators, this game offers realistic moves and replays of spectacular plays or dunks.

Information on team rivalries is provided and includes examples of the NBA's strategies. The graphics on this game are of a decent quality considering the constant movement up and down the court. However, in their efforts to make this game a realistic basketball game around, the developers made the game annoying. Listening to Pappas and Rivers make the same comment is tolerable for so long before the same comment is put to use. Also, the game periodically helps play the ball out of bounds and turn over possession. Although it does happen in the NBA, it makes a video game less realistic.

Any NBA fan will take pleasure in using his or her favorite team to pound his or her least favorite, but in the end, it gets old a little fast. (Grade: C-)

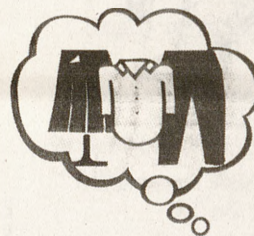

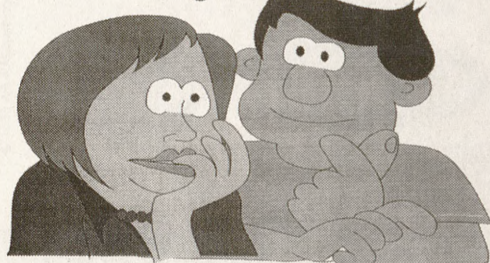

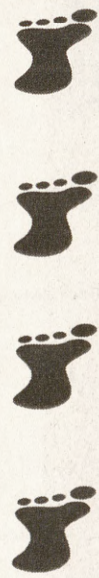
