John said Dallas usually supplies marijuana that is grown in the densely wooded areas of East Texas during the summer months, while Houston may supply marijuana that originates from either East Texas or Mexico, where marijuana is grown year-round because of the warm climate.

Although John said marijuana use is prevalent among A&M students --- he estimates two to three students out of 10 probably have some contact with it every semester - he said the "harder drugs" such as cocaine and heroin are very rare.

"It takes big dealers to be able to afford to move those kind of drugs, so they were around a few years ago," John said. "But now that it is mostly students doing it on the side, you don't see many people who are willing to pay the large amount of money with the risk of not selling it. Personally, I never touch the stuff."

Jones said the use of harder drugs seems to fluctuate. "Drug trends seem to go in cycles," Jones said. "Brazos County's crack cocaine problem hasn't gotten worse, [but] it is pretty easy to set up a distribution network being so close to Houston, which is a cocaine hub.'
