#### Polish filmmaker donates Oscar

WARSAW, Poland (AP) — On his triumphant return from Los Angeles, Polish filmmaker Andrzej Wajda donated his Oscar statue Sunday to the Jagiellonian University in Krakow. "This university is 600 years old. It will be a great honor for this statue to be kept here," Wajda told Polish Radio after a ceremony in Krakow. The 73-year-old filmmaker received this year's honorary Oscar in recognition for his career maneuvering between a repressive communist government and an audience yearning for freedom. "Let this award remind all young

people who visit ... that Polish filmmaking, which has an honorable past, also has a great future," the director said.

Wajda's Oscar will be displayed along with other gifts donated to the university by renowned Polish people, notably the Nobel medal of Krakow poet Wislawa Szymborska.

Wajda's films include the Oscar-nominated *The Maids of Wilk* and *Land of Promise*.

#### Actor receives prize for U.N. donation

ODENSE, Denmark (AP) — Roger Moore, a UNICEF goodwill ambassador since 1991, received

a Hans Christian Andersen Prize Sunday in honor of the Danish tale writer's 195th birthday.

Moore, best known for his roles as James Bond, received an undisclosed amount of money from the U.N. Children's Fund to be given by local entrepreneurs.

An actor disguised as a "Tin Box" gave Moore the prize in a rucksack, saying it was "gold coins."

"You have two hands. One for helping yourself, the other for helping others," Moore told the audience of 2,500, asking them never to forget the world.
