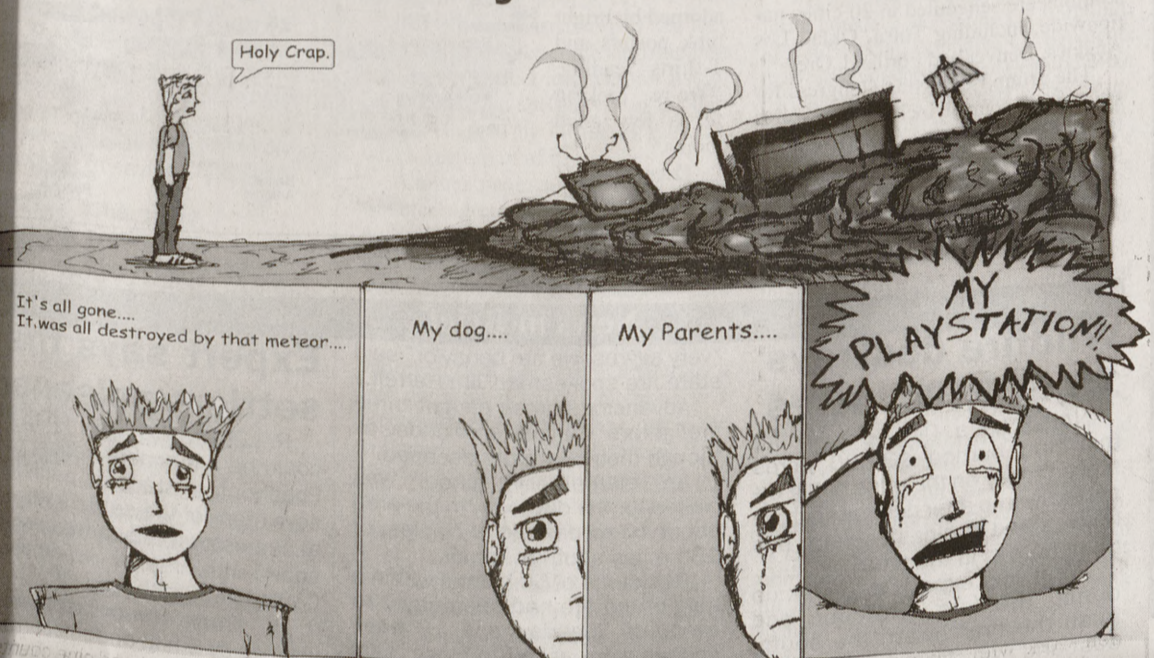

Police accuse of sexual assault

DALLAS (AP) — Two Dallas police officers face charges that they beat and sexually assaulted a 13-year-old boy in their care.
 Lt. William Homer Ransom, 33, and his wife, Sgt. Ransom, 54, were indicted last week on a variety of charges. They remained in jail Tuesday at the Ellis County Jail with bail for each set at \$200,000, authorities told Dallas Morning News in its Wednesday edition.
 Milner said the boy and his sister, who also live with the couple, are Sgt. Ransom's nephew and niece.
 Lt. Ransom was indicted on a count of aggravated assault of a child and on a count of injury to a child. Sgt. Ransom faces one count of aggravated sexual assault of a child, three counts of injury to a child.
 According to a probable cause affidavit filed in February, a sewer worker told Ellis County investigators that she saw a boy with bruises on his back and evidence that he had been sodomized with a cord. A Waxahatchee police officer took the boy to the Medical Center in Waxahatchee where the 4-foot cord removed...
