Men's Golf drops to fifth on back nine at Big 12 Champs

STAFF AND WIRE REPORTS

The Texas A&M men's golf team rallied on the front nine of the final round at the Big 12 Men's Golf Championships on Tuesday and worked into position to make a run for second place.

However, blustery winds took their toll on the back nine, and the Aggies went on to finish fifth at the Prairied Dunes Country Club in Hutchinson, Kan.

Third-ranked Oklahoma State University all but sealed the team championship after finishing Monday afternoon with a tournamentrecord 272. The rest of the field was relegated to playing for second place as the Cowboys took a 10-shot lead into the final day.

The Aggies entered the final round in fourth place, just four strokes behind the defending Big 12 Champion University of Kansas, currently ranked 25th nationally and only one stroke behind No. 17 University of Texas.

After opening Tuesday's round with a four-over-par performance on the front nine, A&M was only two strokes behind the Jayhawks and owned a four stroke lead over Texas.

The Aggies were led by Sean Gilliland who entered the final round in second place in the individual standings and carded a oneover-par 36 on the front nine, as did teammates Matt Lindholm, Dwayne Morley and Josh McCoy. Ty Cox turned in 37.

Just as it appeared the Aggies were gaining momentum, the wind gained strength and ended their chances. The Aggies played the back nine in 27-over-par with only

Lindholm managing to break 40 with a three-over-par 38.

"We were in really good shape after nine holes and had a chance to make a move," A&M coach Bob Ellis said. "But the back side just killed us, just as it did the first two rounds. We just didn't do what we needed to do. Our youth had something to do with it. We need to compete and put ourselves in the position more often. We're disappointed in our finish, and we know we can't play this way at regionals.

We will learn from this and be better prepared for regionals. We know we can be competitive. It was fun to be where we were going into the final nine. That gave us a taste of where we want to be."

Gilliland took a double bogey on the No. 11 hole, followed by a bogey on No. 12 and eventually finance ished with a 41 for a final round of 77. But with the rest of the field also. battling the severe conditions, Gilliland still managed to finish fifth in the individual race.

"My game just went south on the back nine," Gilliland said. "I wasn't moving the ball very well from tee to green or on the greens. The conditions were awfully tough. I've just got to work on playing in pressure situations. I got a little nervous, and my swing got away from me. It seemed like it was that way for the whole team."

Oklahoma State cruised to the team title with a 54-hole total of 851, 12 strokes ahead of runner-up Kansas' 863. Colorado slipped past A&M and Texas into third place at 873, while the Longhorns (876) held off the Aggies (284-289-304=877) by a mere one stroke for fourth.
