English racial attac targets black man

(AP) — A black man was verbally abused and then set on fire Monday, an attack police said was racially motivated.

The 24-year-old man, whose name was not released pending notification of relatives, was listed in stable condition at Selly Oak Hospital with burns to his face and right arm. His injuries were not thought to be life-threatening.

"There appears to be no motive for the attack apart from the fact it was racially motivated," said West Midland Police Detective Chief Inspector Neil James. "It was a particularly vicious attack aggravated by the fact that the victim was abused verbally prior to being set alight."

UNITED NATIONS (AP) bid to deflect criticism of nuclear disarmament reco the five recognized nuclears ers pledged Monday to a pletely eliminate their nu weapons but gave no timefra or new plans to actually get the 1999 Aggie Bor of their arsenals.

In a joint statement, the ed States, Russia, C France and Britain said cated structure to be were "unequivocally com ted" to fulfilling the goal of world free of nuclear arms shrined in the Nuclear Non liferation Treaty.

The statement was issued a U.N. conference reviewing treaty, and was already u criticism from disarman groups as not going far enough


