M:I 2 sets summer movie standard

LOS ANGELES (AP) -- Mission: Impossible 2 blew away the competition and lifted movie theaters' overall box-office record for Memorial Day weekend, according to studio estimates.

Tom Cruise's second caper with Impossible Missions Force grossed \$71.8 million over the weekend, becoming the second-best Memorial Day weekend in 1997.

Overall, the top 12 movies grossed \$174.7 million over the weekend, shattering the record of \$131 million set by the top 50 movies Memorial Day weekend in 1997.

The big weekend gave a boost to this year's overall box office. It is running about 9 percent ahead of 1999, when audiences shelled out record \$7.5 billion.

"What an explosive way to start the summer," said Chuck Viane, head of distribution for Disney, which had No. 2 and No. 3 movies. Disney's nosaur was in second place with \$51 million in its second week, while Chan's comic Western, Shanghai Noon, debuted with \$19.5 million.

The weekend's only other movie, Demi Moore's Passion of the Mind, opened with \$220,000 in 104 theaters. The film, which received weak reviews, averaged a meager \$2,115 a theater.

\$17.3 million, Road Trip at \$14 million and Woody Allen's Small Time Crooks at \$3.9 million.

Gladiator has grossed \$127.2 million, passing Erin Brockovich as the movie so far this year, while Small Time Crooks more than doubled the take of Allen's last movie, Sweet and Lowdown, in just 11 days.

Counting the six days since opening Wednesday, Mission: Impossible 2 took in \$92.8 million, about \$3 million more than the original Mission: Impossible made in its first six days during the 1996 Memorial Day weekend.

The sequel's take so far is more than half the \$181 million the first Mission: Impossible took in domestically for its entire run. The new movie has received generally better reviews than the first, which drew criticism for confusing plot.

"I believe the film plays better than the first one, just based on watching audience reaction in theaters," said Wayne Lewellen, head of distribution for Paramount, which released Mission: Impossible 2.

Playing at 3,653 locations, Mission: Impossible 2 averaged a whopping \$19,655 per theater, compared with \$10,145 in 3,302 cinemas for Dinosaur.

"The enormity of Mission's opening, coupled with the depth of opening movies at the box office, is unparalleled in any other Memorial Day weekend," said Paul Dergarabedian, president of Exhibitor Relations Co., which tracks movie-ticket sales. "Normally, you see one film dominate and the next one at about \$10 million, but to have this many movies in double digits, it's amazing."
