on Tuesday accepted an invitation to ing with the United Nations and temporarily join a U.N. regional group, which gives the Jewish state the chance to be represented on U.N. bodies in New York for the first time in four decades.

The invitation from the U.N. regional group of European, North American and other countries on Friday capped a lengthy campaign led by the United States, Israel's main ally at the United Nations.

"We were told it couldn't be done, but here we are to celebrate it," Holbrooke said. "It is a historic step forward in the elimination of a huge injustice."

The campaign to bring Israel into the world body's fold will continue, because this week's invitation was limited only to the regional group in New York — not in Geneva, Nairobi and Vienna, where the United Nations also operates.

Smokers awarded Two Spanish teem damages in court

MIAMI (AP) - Youth anti-smoking ads produced by tobacco companies are actually recruitment pitches for new customers, a public health expert testified Tuesday in a landmark smoking case.

Dr. Michael Siegel, a specialist on cigarette promotions, singled out the industry's "Think, Don't Smoke" slogan for conveying the opposite of its stated message. Siegel is testifying on behalf of

300,000 to 500,000 sick Florida smokers in a class-action lawsuit.

The jury has already ruled that cigarette companies make a dangerous product and awarded \$12.7 million in compensatory damages to three smokers representing the class.
