Department of Residence Life, said that the purpose of this day is to extend the Aggie spirit.

"Gone to Texas is our official freshman welcome, and we have a resource fair to get students out and meeting each other, but we do not have an official program that is dedicated to helping freshman move in," Muse said.

these small Mexican villages.

"They often say, 'Oh gosh, we never knew it was like this.' They are horrified," Bates said. "One of the important things is to demonstrate caring — that these poor Indians in their villages on the dusty mountain-top are important people, they are humans."

Bates has also worked in other villages in Mexico and Costa Rica. Funding for his efforts comes from A&M, the Allen Foundation, the Episcopal Medical Mission Found-

ation and individual contributions.

Bates has also spent time teaching nutritional courses in Mexico and setting up study abroad programs between Mexico and the United States.

"By developing educational programs [Mexican] universities, we can increase the ability of these universities to do community programs on their own," he said.

Though he will retire soon from A&M, Bates thinks he still has a lot of work to do. He has another 30 years to work on these problems," he said. "I hope to live long enough to see the day when malnutrition is eliminated in Latin America and the Caribbean."
