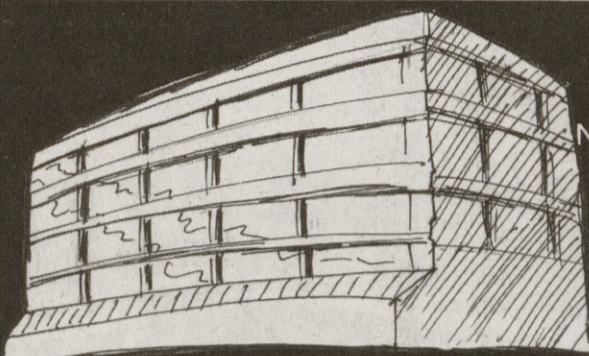

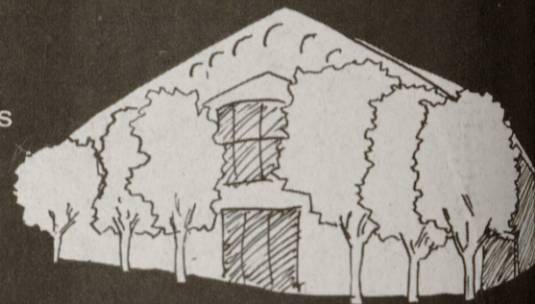


◀ **The Blocker Building**

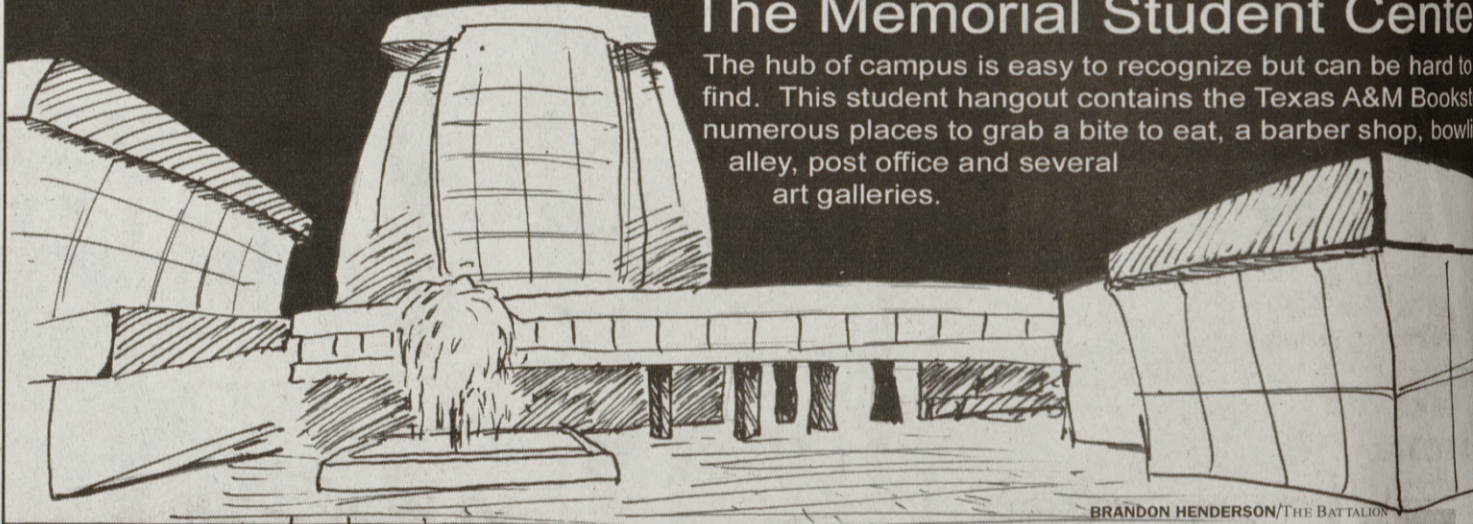
◀ **The Academic Building**

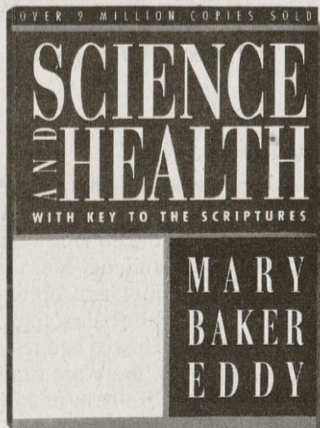
