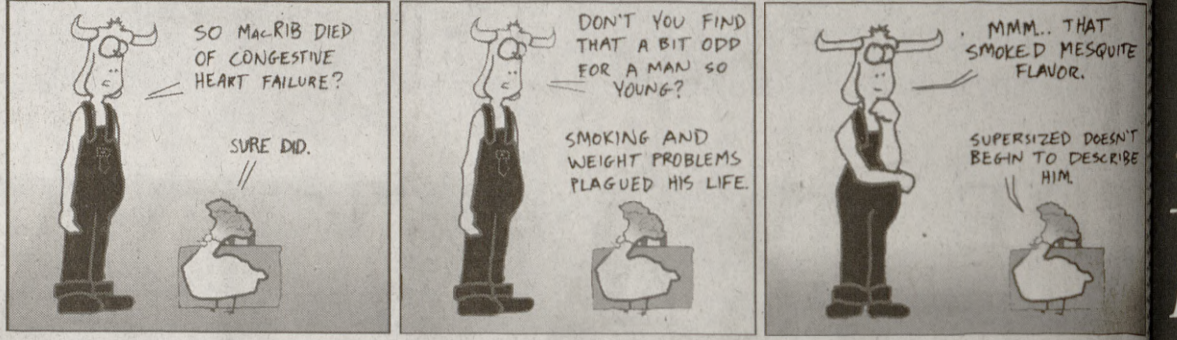

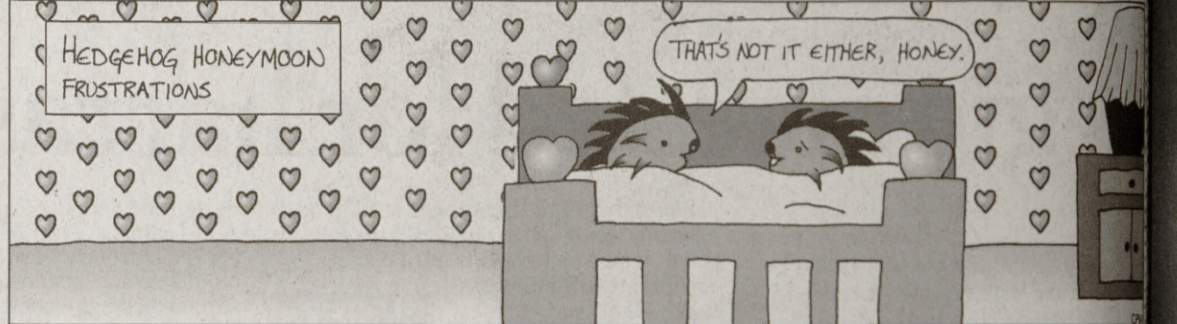

focused on educational measures to cope with the problem of sexually transmitted infections.

Griffith said education is not enough to prevent the dangers associated with sexual activity.

"We know from nationwide statistics that you have to provide people with a convenient means of protecting themselves," she said. "A lot of college students do all types of things spontaneously, and I think sometimes there is a spontaneity to a sexual encounter, which means that often it is not planned and not prepared for."

Griffith and the HIV/AIDS Committee have not approached A&M President Dr. Ray M. Bowen about the proposal, but thinks a student-driven initiative would be far

more effective because the issue is controversial.

Elaine Liao, a senior accounting major, said she thinks condom machines should be installed around campus.

"We are just telling people to be safe," Liao said. "Besides, who am I to tell people not to have sex? So we might as well have something in place in case they do need protection."

One residence hall director said that, before condom machines are installed, housing authorities would have to hear from students that the machines are needed.

Griffith echoed a similar sentiment.

"If students are interested in condom machines, I would like them to contact me so that, between students and the HIV/AIDS Committee we might be able to partner to see if we can get this done," she said.
