





athletes improve significantly? Both, Brown says. In a study publooks nothin lished in the journal The Sciences, Brown reports about the steadily improving performances of athletes since 1900. For example, the record time in the men's 1500-meter run has improved

by about 10 seconds every quartercentury. Men historically have outperformed women, but the gap is narrowing. In a 1992 UCLA study scientists predicted the women would outrun men, especially in endurance races such as the marathon, by 2035.

But humans might soon reach the limits of physical fitness, Brown argues. The overall limiting factor for athletes is the heart's ability to pump more freshly oxygenated blood through miles of blood vessels.
