Their responsibilities as presidents would include taking charge of the council and delegating duties. The vice presidential candidates are Katy Lowe, a freshman English and anthropology major, and Meredith Talley, a freshman general studies major. Clinton official joins UT faculty

AUSTIN (AP) — U.S. Social Security Commissioner Kenneth Apfel will join the faculty at the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas - Austin. Apfel, a 1978 graduate of the LBJ school, will start January 2001, after his term as commissioner ends, the university said Tuesday. Apfel has spent more than two decades in Washington. He worked for more than a decade on Capitol Hill, serving for several years as legislative director to former Sen. Bill Bradley. During the Clinton administration, Apfel served as assistant secretary for management and budget at the Department of Health and Human Services, and as associate director of the Office of Management and Budget before the Senate confirmed him as Social Security Commissioner. Apfel last year was the first recipient of the distinguished alumnus of the University of Texas Graduate School.
