# Taiwan's premier replaced

TAIPEI, Taiwan (AP) - Ta wanese President Chen Shui-bia moved swiftly to replace his resigning premier Wednesday, picking a lor time member of his party to take or as the island's No. 3 ranking leader.

Chen picked Vice Premier Cha Chun-hsiung to replace Tang Fei presidential spokesman said durin news conference. Tang quit Tuesda night, saying his declining healthpr vented him from keeping the job.

The choice of Chang, a lawyera former lawmaker with the president Democratic Progressive Party, mark the president's abandonment of ane fort to find a non-partisan premie who could bridge differences in the legislature. The Taiwanese premier the third most powerful member the government behind the preside and vice president, and one of h main responsibilities is to push theat ministration's policies in the island unruly, fiercely partisan legislature
