Israel gets suspects from mob attack

JERUSALEM (AP) — Less than a week after Israel promised to hunt down the Palestinians who killed and mutilated two soldiers, security sources said Wednesday commandos had captured at least six suspects believed to have taken part in the gruesome mob attack.

Details of the operation were shrouded in secrecy, but in Israel, the news was greeted with grim satisfaction. Israelis were horrified by television footage of the attack, and Prime Minister Ehud Barak himself had promised: "We will settle accounts." Israel's security forces have a long tradition of methodically hunting down those they consider responsible for terrorist attacks against Israeli citizens. After the massacre of 11 Israeli athletes at the 1972 Munich Olympics, the Mossad spy agency spent years tracking down and assassinating the PLO leaders it held responsible.

The timing of these arrests was explosive, coming to light only a day after Israel and the Palestinians promised at a U.S.-brokered summit to try to calm the violence that has been raging for 21 days in the West Bank and Gaza Strip. A Palestinian militia leader, Hussein Sheikh, said if it turned out that Israeli special forces had entered Palestinian-controlled territory to seize the suspects, it would likely provoke an outburst of fury among Palestinians.

One. "Now, you give us the right to go after those who killed Mohammed al-Dura" — a 12-year-old Palestinian boy slain in a hail of Israeli gunfire in the Gaza Strip on Sept. 30 as his father desperately tried to shield him.

So sensitive was the matter — raising questions of whether Yasser Arafat's Palestinian Authority had cooperated with or at least known of the Israeli operation — that the arrests were not even reported in official Palestinian media, and Palestinian officials declined all comment.

Israeli officials, too, refused to discuss the case for the record, but broadly hinted that arrests had taken place and more were possible. "I don't want to go into detail about what has been done, and certainly not on what is to be done ... that could only spoil things," Deputy Defense Minister Ephraim Sneh told Israel's Channel Two.

Israeli security sources said the six were arrested overnight on Monday evening until Tuesday morning by commandos from the army's elite Sayeret Matkal unit, which specializes in clandestine operations, assisted by other special Israeli forces.

There was no immediate word on the fate of the suspects. The sources said only that they were in Israel and were being interrogated. Some Israeli media reports put the number of those arrested as high as eight.

The assailants were identified from film footage of the attack shot by an Italian TV crew, which showed the mob breaking into a Palestinian police station in Ramallah to get to a pair of Israelis picked up by Palestinian West Bank town. Israel said the military reservists got lost while trying to find their base, but many in the mob believed they were Israeli undercover agents.

In chilling detail, the jumpy, grainy footage showed some of the mob climbing into a second-story window of the building, a shadowy scuffle taking place — and then one of the assailants appearing framed by the window, his bloody hands raised in triumph.

Israeli media reports about the arrests referred repeatedly to "the one with the bloody hands" — whose picture was splashed on the front pages of newspapers the next day — having been among the suspects seized.

The TV footage went on to show the soldiers' bodies being dumped headfirst from the window to the waiting mob, which fell upon them with sticks and bars. Their corpses were so mangled that reports in Israel said they had to be identified from dental records and fingerprints.
