

Four men question

ADEN, Yemen (AP) — Four men the bombing are bel arrested over the past two days are being questioned about the fatal bombing of the USS Cole last month, sources close to the investigation said Monday.

The newest suspects were tracked down through phone records showing that the suspected bombers had been in contact with them, the sources said on condition of anonymity.

All four live in the southern port city of Aden, where the two suspected suicide bombers blew up a small boat filled with explosives alongside the Cole on Oct. 12 as it prepared to day that authorities have to refuel. Seventeen Americans were


Florida smokers receive record amo MIAMI (AP) — A Florida circuit judge Monday upheld a record

\$145 billion award to Florida smokers, rejecting tobacco industry re to reduce the award and conduct a new trial.

Circuit Judge Robert Kaye issued the comprehensive 68-page the same day he received a federal judge's decision rejecting file risdiction and sending the case back to him.

There was no immediate reaction from attorneys on either side received the unexpected order shortly after the tobacco industrial nounced plans to file a notice of appeal on the jurisdiction issue.
