Earnhardt crashes days after father dies

ROCKINGHAM, N.C. — After seven of the hardest days of his life, Dale Earnhardt Jr. was racing.

He did not even finish a race similar to the one that killed his last week in the Daytona 500. He walked away from his car and not seriously injured.

"Today was probably the day on him, as far as his dad, going here to go to the drivers' with him and stuff like that. Tony Eury Jr., Earnhardt's and a member of his crew.

"We was all just wanting today, basically. That's the fact that we can really put it behind us. The green flag had just dropped the Dura Lube 400 when the old Earnhardt guided his red car across the start/finish line at Carolina Speedway.

He started the race in the 29th position, far back from the leader's double-file line. He sailed to turn 1 with no problems. He made it through Turn 2, quickly in on the cars in front of him.

But the field began to get together as the cars jockeyed for position heading into Turn 3. Robby Gordon slid down the track and front of Earnhardt.
