After sweeping the Austin University Lady Aggie basketball team, the Texas A&M team takes its act on the court at the University of Texas-Lady Mavs today at 6 p.m. at Saxe Field.

The Lady Mavs come in game after a 2-1 loss to A&M-Corpus Christi last week, lost the Lady Mavs 75-51 overall.
